

Pohoda Únanov Camping Site Rules and Regulations

1. The camping site Rules and Regulations apply to the grounds designated for tents, caravans and motor homes in the Pohoda Únanov Camping Site operated by the Municipality of Únanov, 671 31, Únanov 463, Company Registration Number: 00293725 (hereinafter "Accommodation Provider" or "Operator").
2. The camping site offers accommodation only to visitors duly registered with a valid ID at the reception located at the entrance to the grounds where the accommodation fee will also be paid. The fee is to be paid by the guests in advance.
3. If the reception is not open at the time of the visitors' arrival, and if their booked space has been vacated, visitors may get settled there and plug into electrical service using the hookup with the number corresponding to the space number. These visitors must check in at the earliest opportunity after the reception reopens.
4. Following check-in and payment of all due fees, visitors will be given a payment receipt and a corresponding number of identification bracelets indicating the length of stay. Each visitor must wear their bracelet at all times throughout the stay.
5. The Accommodation Provider allocates caravan or tent spaces to visitors based on a reservation or agreement. In special cases, visitors may be allocated a slightly different but comparable space which does not vary significantly from the one agreed on and confirmed in the reservation.
6. The number of accommodated visitors is limited by the capacity of the camping site.
7. When on the grounds or returning to the grounds, a visitor's identification bracelet may be checked by the Operator's staff member to prove the visitor's right to stay.
8. The identification bracelet entitles camp visitors to a discount on the entrance fee to the outdoor swimming pool Pohoda.
9. Visitors of the camp must not be carriers of a contagious disease or suffering from contagious or parasitic diseases or ordered increased medical supervision or quarantined.
10. Unless otherwise agreed, check-in is from 12:00 (noon). The accommodation unit – camping space must be vacated on the last day of the stay by 10:00 a.m. for check-out. If the visitors fail to do so, the Operator may charge them the accommodation fee for another day as if used fully. If the caravan or tent space is already booked by another visitor, it is not possible to extend the length of the stay at the same space.
11. All registered camp visitors are free to use all camp amenities and services provided by the Operator on condition that they follow the Operator's rules.
12. Camp visitors are obliged to keep the area clean and orderly at all times. Tents can be pitched and vehicles parked only in the designated spaces. The visitors must comply with both the municipal regulations of Únanov as well as general regulations.
13. Camp visitors are obliged to dispose of their waste in bins intended for the purpose in designated areas.
14. Visitors are obliged to comply with the quiet hours between 10 p.m. and 7 a.m.
15. On the grounds, it is obligatory to keep the noise down also during the day so as not to disturb other guests with shouting, noisy singing, excessively turned up music etc.
16. It is not allowed to make open fires. There is a barbecue grill at the visitors' disposal on the grounds provided they do not bother other visitors with smoke.
17. It is not allowed to mark your own boundaries of the caravan or tent space by digging or any other means.
18. Washing motor vehicles and their maintenance is strictly forbidden at the camping site.
19. Visitors' vehicles as well as those of other people staying at the camping site may be parked only in designated spaces and with the consent of the Operator. The Operator reserves the right to have a vehicle towed if it is parked in violation of the aforementioned provision, i.e. in a space not designated as such and without the Operator's consent.
20. For safety reasons, visitors are not allowed to use their own electric appliances on the grounds. This rule does not apply to small body-care and hygiene appliances (shaving and massage equipment, hairdryers).
21. For safety reasons, children may not be left unsupervised by adults on the grounds.
22. Children may use the playground only in the presence of a responsible adult. Ball games and other sports may be played only on courts or in areas intended for the purpose. All sports activities on the grounds are carried out at the visitors' own risk. The Municipality of Únanov shall not be held liable for any injuries or damage to health that might occur due to carelessness or non-compliance with the safety principles by the visitor.

23. Dogs are allowed at the camping site on condition that their owner proves their acceptable health condition on request. The owner is responsible for the dog's actions at all times. The owner makes sure their dog does not bother other camp visitors. The dog owners are obliged to make sure that their dogs do not run free on the grounds! They are also obliged to walk the dogs outside the camping site.
24. The Operator shall not be held liable for any loss or damage to the visitors' property that might occur unless these have been caused by the camp staff member. Likewise, the Operator shall not be held liable for items left unattended.
25. No area on the grounds is a guarded parking lot. Cars and other means of transport at the camping site are not guarded. The Municipality of Únanov shall therefore not be liable for their possible damage or theft.
26. Each guest must get acquainted with these Rules and Regulations and comply with them. By paying for the stay the guest confirms having got acquainted with the Rules and Regulations.
27. The Rules and Regulations are binding for all at the camping site. Any person who violates the Camping Site Rules and Regulations will be expelled from the grounds without compensation.
28. The Operator shall not be held liable for damage to the visitors' property inflicted by third parties, due to weather conditions, falling branches or other cases of force majeure.
29. If a camp visitor causes damage to the property of the Operator or other camp visitors, he/she shall be held liable for such damage under current legislation.
30. Found property shall be taken to and left at the reception where it is entered in Lost & Found.
31. Some common grounds of the camping site, marked by an informative pictogram, are monitored by the Operator's surveillance cameras for security reasons.
32. By paying the fee, each accommodated person acknowledges the Information on the Processing of Personal Data, available at the reception, on the website www.autokemp-unanov.cz and www.obecunanov.cz.

These Rules and Regulations were adopted by Únanov Municipality Council Resolution No. 5/2019 dated 24 April 2019.
